## The SAVE Act:

### The Bill That Could Block Millions of Americans From Voting

### **Topic of Conversation**:

The Safeguard American Voter Eligibility (SAVE) Act reintroduced in the U.S. House of Representatives would require all Americans to prove their citizenship status by presenting documentation—in person—when registering to vote or updating their voter registration information. Specifically, the legislation would require the vast majority of Americans to rely on either 1) a passport or 2) a birth certificate in combination with a government-issued photo ID to prove their citizenship. While this may sound easy for many Americans, the reality is that more than **140 million American citizens** do not possess a passport, as many as **69 million women** who have taken their spouse's name do not have a birth certificate matching their legal name, and **millions of transgender Americans** do not possess these documents reflecting the name they use. Additionally, the in-person requirements of the bill would mean accessible voter registration systems that tens of millions of citizens, including 60 million rural Americans, rely on every election cycle would no longer be available. The SAVE Act would force some rural Americans to **drive up to eight hours round trip**, and even cross state lines, just to update their voter registration information.
